CDOT FLAGGER TRAINING

The CIRSA Risk Control team will be hosting five regional CDOT Flagger
Training classes for members. This training aims to improve work zone safety
as well as provide an understanding of the potential dangers and hazards that are
present on roadway construction and maintenance projects. Flaggers play a vital role
in protecting both the traveling public and the workers. This 4-hour course follows CDOT's
requirements for flagging based on the Flaggers Training Manual, Reference Guide and CDOT's
Flagging video.

These five regional courses are the only flagger courses we will be offering until our new trainer is fully up to speed. Thus, if these locations and dates do not work for your entity, we will begin rescheduling all previously canceled courses in the order they were received and will do so as quickly as we can. We do project that scheduling process to begin around the same time we are rolling out these regional courses.
