

Dangers of Topping Off Your Gas Tank

- Overfilling your gas tank can damage your vehicle leading to costly repairs and reduced vehicle lifespan.
- Gasoline vapors released from overfilling contribute to ground level ozone, which is a harmful air pollutant that affects people and the environment.
- Excess gas from topping it off may be absorbed back into the station's tank, meaning you could pay for fuel you don't receive.
  - Conduct regular vehicle inspections of fuel tanks, vapor recovery system and emissions control components to ensure they are working correctly.
    - Implementing a 'No Topping Off' policy can reduce vehicle repair costs and prevent fuel waste.
      - Increase awareness by training everyone on the hazards of topping off.
