

This new course will provide participants with a basic understanding of playground safety and the importance of identifying and correcting common hazards associated with playgrounds & related equipment. Modules will cover playground components, surfacing, and use zones, with a focus on hazard identification, correction, and proper maintenance. This newly created hybrid-course will require both a classroom and a post-course assignment to be completed to obtain the completion certificate. This course is intended for staff responsible for the maintenance and management of public playgrounds. However, staff that manage budgets and/or those with ADA responsibilities may benefit from the context and understanding of the complexities of playground maintenance and improvement.
